

Patient evaluation is carried out through a high-definition morphological and functional analysis, exploring proportions, symmetries, muscular dynamics, and possible disharmonies.

The use of ultrasound enables precise mapping of deep structures and risk areas, ensuring a personalized and layered treatment plan.

During the **interactive live injection**, theoretical planning takes practical form: the treatment is performed in real time, and every operative choice—from the injection plane to the depth of product placement—is guided by a clinical reasoning process focused on safety, accuracy, and respect for anatomical architecture. The audience is given the opportunity to follow the logical decision-making sequence underpinning the technical act, beyond mere manual skill.

The session concludes with a **panel discussion**, a high-level critical debate between the injector and the panelists. Through the analysis of clinical cases, the comparison of operative variables, and the sharing of strategies for complication management, a multidisciplinary body of knowledge is built. Finally, the Q&A session with the audience consolidates an ethical and responsible approach to aesthetic practice.







The session then proceeds to the interactive **live injection**, where the information gathered during the preliminary phase is translated into concrete operative choices. Each technical step is justified by clinical evaluations aimed at precision, safety, and respect for individual anatomy.

This is followed by the **panel discussion**, offering a structured moment of exchange: the injector and the attending experts analyze clinical cases, alternative approaches, and possible complications, presenting complementary perspectives on the subject. The session concludes with a dedicated Q&A, fostering a deeper exploration of the content and encouraging an open, informed dialogue with the audience.

Every technical action is driven by clinical considerations focused on precision, safety, and respect for individual anatomy.

Finally, the **panel discussion** concludes the session: the injector and the attending experts discuss clinical cases, different approaches, and potential complications, offering multiple perspectives on the same topic. The subsequent Q&A session allows for deeper insights and fosters an open and informed exchange with the audience.

Supporting research can truly make a difference because discovering and studying cancer in time today means having a much greater chance of curing it tomorrow!

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


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
